

MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW
FEBRUARY 2025

February 2025 was a very warm, partly cloudy month with below average rain.

The rainfall total of 50.2 millimetres was 38 mm less than the average with most of it falling from thunderstorms. The highest daily fall was 24.6 mm on the 12th.

Temperatures were a little higher than normal, but day temperatures reached higher than 29.9C on only one day, the 28th.

There were no notable temperature extremes.

Thunderstorm activity was close to normal with storms on five days, no hail was observed with any of the storms.

Winds were mostly light easterlies which is normal for late summer.

There were no noteworthy events.
